PRATICIAL INFORMATION

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The project called TOM for Climate Change is aimed to train and support youth workers on new media technologies for informing the youth on climate changes. By the training course, we aimed to raise the awareness the importance of the climate problems and the innovative solutional approaches to use the new technologies.

During the course we will inform the participants on the topics as below:

- What is climate change and how we deal with climate problems? Awareness points on the theme.
- New approaches on climate change and technical details about calculation of carbon emission
- YIA programme and new approaches for informing the youth.
- New media tools and how to use these tools.

WE WILL SEND THE TRAINING PROGRAMME VERY SOON.

- **Participants Profile:** The person who is interested in the topic of climate change, works as a volunteer of the organization. The participant should have no language barrier. This training course aims to be valorized by the participants after the implementation. We expect the participants to prepare an informative seminar, small presentation of this project during their own valorization activities when they will go back to their countries.

PREPARATION:

We expect the participants group to search about the climate change issue and collect information about their organizations before coming to the training course.

And also do not forget to bring some traditional music for the intercultural evenings! Every country will have a short time for presenting their culture. We hope, that your culture means you something more than national food and drinks.

TRAVEL BUDGET LIMIT FOR THE PARTICIPANTS:

The New Generation Development Association will reimburse **70% of participants' travel costs from your home city to Istanbul, Turkey.**

Reimbursement of travel costs will only be done upon presentation of **all** (including return) **original tickets, receipt/invoices and boarding passes** and later sending of the return documents and boarding passes. **Your must use public transport! (Bus, metro, tram)**

Please keep the **boarding tags** from your airport check in as well. Reimbursement will be done in EURO, regardless of the currency indicated on your ticket and receipt/invoice.

You must come from the country that you applied our project. **(For example, if you participate from St.Petersburg, you must come from St.Petersburg) The participants have to come the city which you write to the PART3 forms.**

PROJECT VENUE & CONDITIONS

The project will be held in İstanbul.

For the project venue, probably we will prefer to organize a hostel in the city centre called TAXİM. And we will organize the University of Istanbul Technical NGO office for the training. Also we will have our lunch and dinner at the university.
