The map of community is the self-representation by the inhabitants of a certain place of the heritage, landscape, and knowledge in which they recognize themselves. It often arises as a way of remembering and transmitting to new generations. It has the merit of highlighting the way in which the local community is seen and perceived; it indicates the elements of its territory to which value is attributed; it highlights personal and collective memories, and can also represent transformations, the current reality and its future. It is useful for creating awareness with respect to the territory, and to its widespread heritage, rich in details and a network of relationships and interrelations between the many elements that distinguish it. Preparing a community map means starting a process aimed at obtaining a permanent, and always updatable, "archive" of the people and places of a territory.
